

Privacy Policy for the following websites and its subsections

FEDERAL MOGUL ITALY srl. registered with the register court city Cuneo under the registration number Ref. No. R.E.A. 243716 having its registered seat in Mondovi' (CN), Italy and its business address at Corso Inghilterra n. 2 – 12084 MONDOVI' (CN), Italy, P.I. IT00476190012 (hereinafter referred to as “**Company**”) is responsible for the websites listed above (hereinafter referred to as “**Websites**”).

Data privacy protection is taken very seriously by the Company. It is committed to collect and use all personal data in compliance with the applicable data privacy laws. By using the Websites or by registering at the Websites or any other subsections of the Websites (e.g. Reserved Area), the user agrees to the following privacy policy (hereinafter referred to “**Privacy Policy**”). If the user does not agree to the Privacy Policy, he/she must renounce the use and/or registration.

When using the Websites and its subsections (together also referred to as “**Portal**”), the Company collects personal data in different places. Based on this Privacy Policy, the Portal intends to explain the user which data is vital and how the user may enjoy extra benefits by providing additional personal data voluntarily.

General

The user may also use the Portal without registration or login. However, individual sections of the Portal may require prior registration.

While the user is visiting the Portal, the Company's web server collects general technical information for the operation of the Portal; this particularly includes information about the soft- and hardware used by the user, the computer's IP address, the websites called up by the user and the time and duration of the visit. The collected data is not linked to any registration data.

Collection and use of data

For a personalized use of the Portal or for contact purposes, users might have to enter personal information. To this end, personal data is collected: e.g. user name, title, first and last name and/or e-mail address.

All the information will only be used to fulfil the contractual business purpose and to provide the user with the relevant Portal's services related. If the user has also consented to the use of other websites of the Federal-Mogul Group and/or the mostly affiliated companies, his/her data will also be used to fulfil these purposes. The user's consent to the collection, storage or use of the data will be logged.

Users have the right to object to the use of their data for advertising, direct marketing or market/opinion research purposes at any time and free of charge.

Eventually, the users can enter additional data in corresponding forms voluntarily.

The Company performs analyses of the users' behavior on the Portal sites. This is done because the Portal wants to continually improve its service. These analyses are not personal but are conducted in an aggregated manner so that they cannot be assigned to the user.

Legal Basis for the collection and use of data

If consent is obtained by the user for the collection and use of their data, the data processing will be based on Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR. In this case you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. If the processing of personal user data is necessary for the performance of a contract, the data processing will be based on Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR. Should data processing be necessary for the compliance with a legal obligation, this process will be based on Article 6 (1) (c) GDPR.

Lastly, should the processing of user data be necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interest pursued by the company or a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the user, which require protection of personal data, the data

processing shall be based on Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR. In this case, the data processing is necessary for the personalized use of the portal and various other services and informational content provided on these websites and to further improve user experience. Personal data will only be processed and stored for a period of time, which is necessary to fulfill the intended purpose it was obtained for or any legal statutes dictate further storage of data. Afterwards, personal data will be deleted, anonymized or aggregated to remove all identifying features (“anonymized”). Further descriptions and explanations regarding each data processing and the provided safety measures in regards to data processing, can be found in this privacy policy.

Reserved Area

The company offers its customers an online ordering tool, accessible via the “Reserved Area” (<http://b2b.ferodoracing.com/login>). Customers may log in using their personalized customer code and password, they receive while they first order from the company. Customers are able to see necessary product information (e.g. stock quantity) to order their desired products.

The login profile includes the company name, email address, password and country. Should personal data be included in the before mentioned profile, this will only be processed to fulfill the contractual relationship with our customers and will be based on Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR. The data will be processed, as long as it is necessary to fulfill the contractual relationship with the individual customer, in addition legally mandated retention periods may apply.

Additionally, the following data will be processed when logging into the reserved area, to insure the technical functionality and safety of the website: IP-Address, Browser-Information, time and duration of login. Only the last two standard access logs containing login information will be stored.

Google Analytics

Subject to your prior consent where required under applicable law, these websites uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. (“Google”). Google Analytics uses so-called “cookies”, text files which are stored on your computer and allow an analysis of your use of the website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website (including your IP address) is transferred to a server by Google in the USA and is stored there. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google’s behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the installation of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser; however, please note that if you do this, you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. By using this website, you declare your agreement to the processing of the data about you collected by Google in the way described above and for the purpose indicated above. Data collected via Google Analytics will be stored for a period of 26 months.

You may object to the collection and storage of data at any time with effect for the future [using <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=de>]. Given the debate about the use of analytical tools with full IP addresses, we would like to point out that this website uses Google Analytics with the extension “_anonymizeIp()” so that IP addresses are only processed in shortened form to prevent them from being directly linked to a particular individual.

Please note that personally identifiable information which is directly circulated by the user in chats, forums or other public communication programmes may be collected and used by other individuals.

Newsletter Tracking

This website uses the Newsletter tracking-software by *Selligent SA, (Avenue de Finlande 2, bte 2, 1420 Braine-l’Alleud, Belgium)* to evaluate the efficiency of Newsletters sent to users. If the user signs up for any of the Newsletter-Services provided by this website, the tracking-software will be implemented in any newsletter sent. The software will track whether or not and when the newsletter was delivered, opened, viewed or which content was clicked on. It will also take information into account you may have provided while signing up for the Newsletter or service. This includes information on which key field (Installer, Engine rebuilder, just a fan of cars, Distributer, Do it yourself) interests you, your name, phone number, country, gender and language preference. This information

will be used to create personal profiles and general reports to improve user experience and performance optimization.

The user has to consent to the Newsletter Tracking when signing up for any of the newsletters, by ticking the check box next to the text:

"Please sign me up for the Newsletter. This Newsletter is tracked, for more information please check our Privacy Policy. You may opt out of this process at any time by clicking the link at the bottom of each newsletter."

and clicking "Join". The user may opt out of the Newsletter Tracking at any time by clicking the link at the bottom of each newsletter.

Use of personal data

The Portal does not transfer, sell or rent the user's personal data collected to any third parties, except as expressly described below.

If the user consents to being contacted for direct marketing purposes, he/she will be actively informed about the Company's products or services by email and/or via post. Users may also be contacted on behalf of external business partners to submit them special offers which may be of interest to them.

The Portal is jointly operated by the Company and its subsidiaries together with other cooperation partners. For the operation of the jointly operated website, it is necessary that the data collected is made available to the respective other company or the respective cooperation partner.

For the purposes described herein, personal data may also be transferred within and outside the European Economic Area, including in countries that may not be recognized by the EU Commission as providing an adequate level of protection of personal data. The company shall implement appropriate safeguards to cover such transfers in accordance with applicable law.

Use of cookies

The Portal uses "cookies" to facilitate the use of the website and to offer additional functionality. A cookie is a text file which is copied from a web server onto the user's hard disk. Cookies cannot execute programs or infect the user's computer with a virus. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to support the user in browsing the website and to simplify entries. If required, settings which have already been saved can be recalled so that the user can more easily use the websites customized by the user. The user can either accept or reject cookies. The majority of web browsers accept cookies automatically. Users may also adapt their browser settings for cookies to their needs. If a user rejects the use of cookies, he/she may not benefit fully from all the interactive options of the Portal.

Particularly applications which are technically dependent on the use of cookies may not work in such a case or may require a new cookie to be placed.

If users do not agree to the use of cookies by the Portal, they can deactivate the saving and use of their interests and reactivate them at a later point in time in their browser settings. Potential tracking cookies are turned off using the same mechanisms by placing a so-called "opt-out cookie" on the user's computer to prevent anonymized data collection. Should you delete all your cookies, please note that the opt-out cookie will also be deleted and might have to be installed again.

Use of social plugins from YouTube

In order to make the website more attractive and user-friendly, we integrate social plugins from [Youtube.com](https://www.youtube.com) on our website. These plugins are usually marked by a logo of the co-operation partner and a written addition.

As soon as the user access a page of the website with such a plugin, the user's browser will set up a direct, short connection to its servers. This is mainly used to display the content of the plugin. In this case, the co-operation partner will gain knowledge of the user's IP address. In practice, this IP address cannot be assigned directly to the user. In certain circumstances, the platform provider may store a cookie on the user's computer (see "Use of cookies" above). If the user wants to allow these cookies depends on the settings of the user's browser.

Google Maps

This website uses Google Maps from Google Inc. By using this website, the user agrees to the collection, processing and use of the automated data collected by Google Inc, its agents and third parties. The terms of use of Google Maps can be found

Control of your personal data

Users can withdraw their consent to the storage of their personal data at any time in written or electronic form. Furthermore, users can withdraw their consent to the collection and storage of their voluntarily provided data by the Portal at any time.
